



Shooting Australia Fellowship Award

The Shooting Australia (SA) Fellowship is awarded to individuals who have made a significant contribution to the advancement of the sport of shooting. Recipients are expected to continue their involvement in the sport and to aid the understanding and development of the shooting sports.

It is expected that the SA Fellowship recipient(s) be present at a major SA event or the SA Awards of Excellence to receive the award.

The Recipients of the SA Fellowship, which is awarded from time to time, are designated **Shooting Australia Fellows** and will receive a significant plaque and pin.

Nominations for the Shooting Australia Fellowship Award

SA invites nominations for individuals, who have made substantial contributions to the shooting sports perpetuating the spirit and work of SA.

The SA Board will consider all nominations and make the final decision.

Nominations for the Shooting Australia Fellowship must include:

- A nomination letter from an SA affiliated Member Body, which provides the reasons for the nomination and explains the nominee's significant contribution to shooting sport.
- The nominator is required to supply the nominee's curriculum vitae and a list of his/her major achievements. The nominator should also supply the current address and contact information for the nominee.
- Letters of support from recognized individuals who have substantial knowledge of the work of the nominee.

Nominations can be submitted for consideration at any time and if successful, the nominee will be presented at the following annual SA Awards of Excellence or similar event. Some candidates may continue to be considered in following years.
